

Social dialogue:

Collective bargaining:

- Sectoral: dominant bargaining level; Hospital sector
- Process: Negotiations and agreement between social partners, approval by members
- Main Outcome: Collective agreement (CA)
- Coverage:
 - □ Always: legally binding for all employees working for signatory employers
 - Mostly: declared legally binding for all by special procedure

Other levels of influence of social partners:

■ Regular meetings with the Ministry of Health, Welfare and Sport





Labour market Foundation; <u>StAZ</u> (Organisation for Social Partners in Hospitals in the Netherlands)

- Who: Social partners (NVZ and ABVAKABO FNV, CNV Publieke Zaak, FBZ, NU'91)
- Aim: Contribute to a well-functioning labour market and high quality care work
- How: Means to reach this aim





EU topics and Dutch social partners in hospital sector

- Special StAZ Europe working group, consisting of social partners
- Topics discussed
- Informing stakeholders
- Active exchange with other EU countries by study trip (London trip) and EU projects (task realignment)





Code of conduct on cross-border ethical recruiting

Steps taken:

- Issue taken up as important by StAZ board and referred to the special StAZ Europe working group
- <u>Translation</u> of the code of conduct to Dutch for accessibility of stakeholders
- Two meetings especially dedicated to the code of conduct
- <u>Evaluation</u> of the code of conduct in light of legislation and initiatives by Dutch authorities, agreements between special partners and initiatives taken by social partners






Code of conduct on cross-border ethical recruiting

Results:

- Code of conduct and evaluation accessible to stakeholders, as available in Dutch and English and posted on the <u>StAZ</u> website
- Clear overview of measures/gaps in relation to the implementation of code of conduct
- Agreement to black list recruitment agencies not complying to ethical recruitment practices ad described in this code by publication on StAZ website
- The code of conduct and WHO code
