



## **Background materials and information:** Related Project (2014-2016)

A previous joint project that focused on **musculoskeletal disorders** and **psycho-social risks and stress at work** aimed towards the promotion of occupational safety and health. Through this project, the social partners aim to identify how preventive actions can contribute to improved workers' health and safety, to more attractive retention conditions in the hospital sector and to improved efficiency in the management of healthcare institutions by reducing the negative effects linked to these occupational risks. They also looked at and **discussed the instruments needed to achieve healthy and safe working conditions**. HOSPEEM and EPSU achieved these objectives through the exchange of knowledge and the identification of existing good practice.
