## Public consultation on EU Strategic Framework on Health and Safety at Work

The **aim** of this open public consultation is to take stock of the quality and implementation of the Strategic Framework on Health and Safety at Work 2014-2020 and to receive input for the future Strategic Framework 2021-2027. This open public consultation will be available for 12 weeks from **7 December to 1 March 2021**.

## SECTION 1: GENERAL VIEWS ON OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH

The EU Strategic Framework on Health and Safety at Work 2014-2020 supports the promotion of high standards for occupational safety and health both within the EU and internationally. It aims to address the major health and safety at work challenges facing the EU through the implementation of a range of different actions at national and EU level.

One of the main practical solutions to address all these challenges is the involvement of national and EU level cross-sectoral and sectoral social partners in the decision-making process of national governments and that of the European institutions. By strengthening and respecting the role and autonomy of social partners, in particular sector specific occupational safety and health challenges, will be addressed and solved more effectively. Within the framework of the European (sectoral) social dialogue practical solutions or approaches can be shared easily and potentially implemented in other countries.

A practical solution, not only to address psycho-social stress and risk at work, increased work intensity, blurring of work-private life, but also risk emerging from robotics, is to implement the European cross-sectoral social partners agreement on digitalisation. The implementation will enable employers and unions to introduce digital transformation strategies in partnership in a human oriented approach at national, sectoral, company and workplace levels, including on the modalities of connecting and disconnecting and respect of working time rules and appropriate measures to ensure compliance.

Regarding risk from dangerous substances, in particular hazardous medicinal products including cytotoxic substances, the elaboration of EU guidance for the safe handling of these products is essential by also engaging in consultation with social partners.

Risks range from mental health due to adaptation to new working methods and increase in work-related diseases due to a shift to sedentary work.
